


# Monday

**Option 1: hand-over-hand**




**Option 2: make borders around the lines with very thick glue or thin snakes of modeling dough and let dry**



**Option 3: Color inside the letter with white crayon and let child paint the whole page**








## Letter Dots


Option 1: Use dot paint sticks or paint on a cotton ball to paint in each circle




Option 2: Fill each circle with plastic counters, pennies or cereal




Option 3: Use finger paint to put a thumbprint in each circle



## Shape with Modeling Dough



**Option 1: Use dot paint sticks or paint on a cotton ball to cover the letter**






**Option 2: Cover the letter with plastic counters, pennies or cereal**


# Friday
