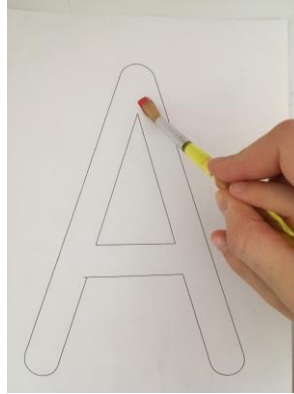

Option 1: hand-over-hand

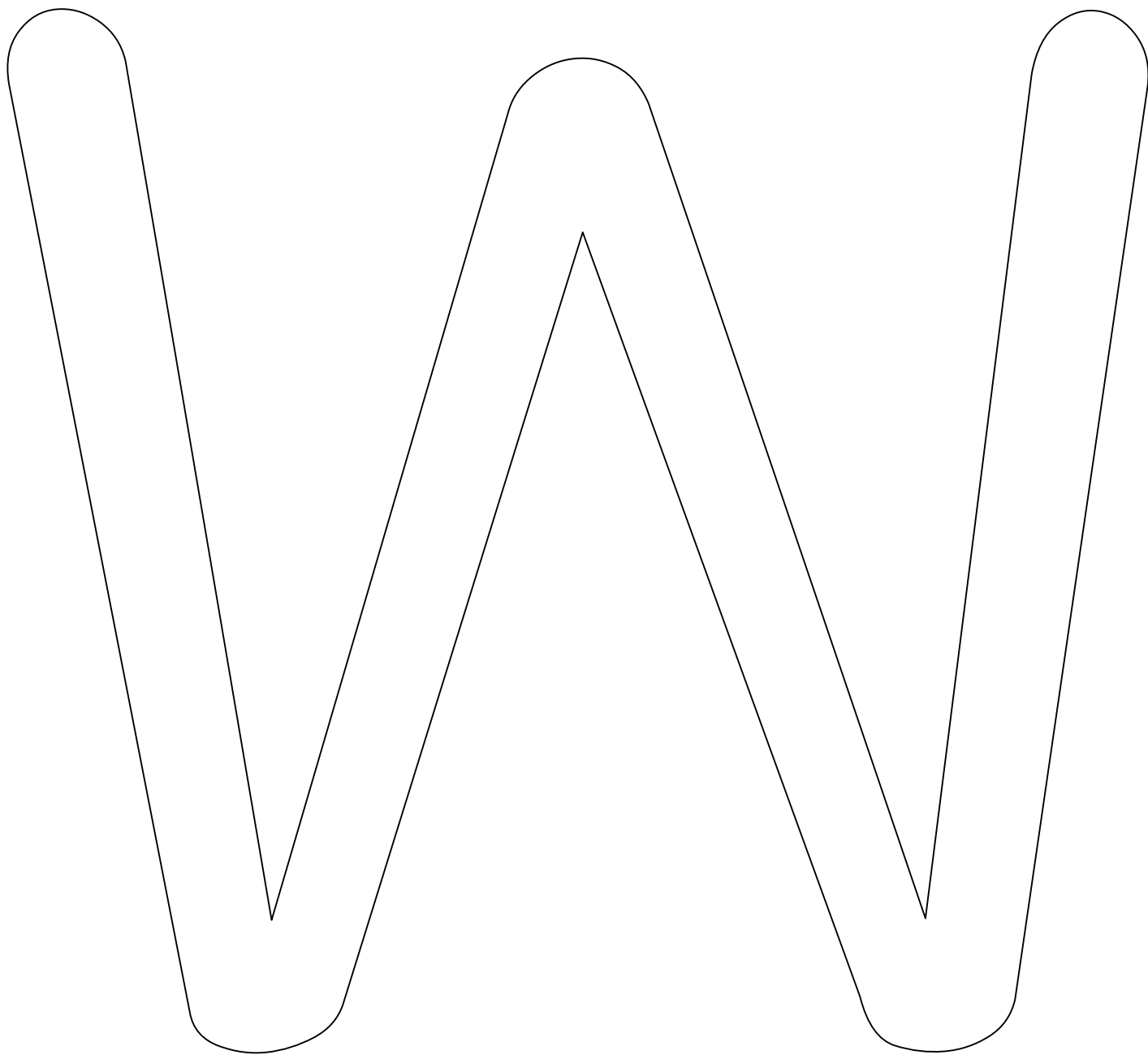


Option 2: make borders around the lines with very thick glue or thin snakes of modeling dough and let dry



Option 3: Color inside the letter with white crayon and let child paint the whole page

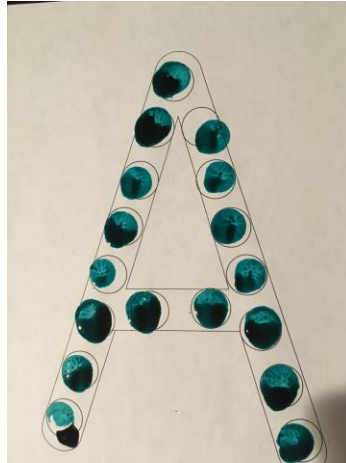




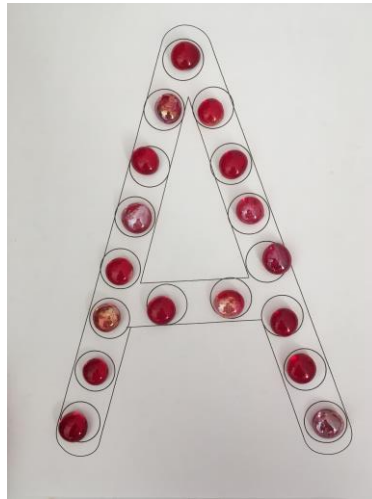

## Letter Dots

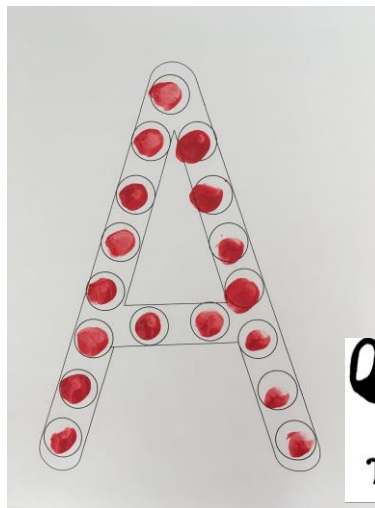
Option 1: Use dot paint sticks or paint on a cotton ball to paint in each circle

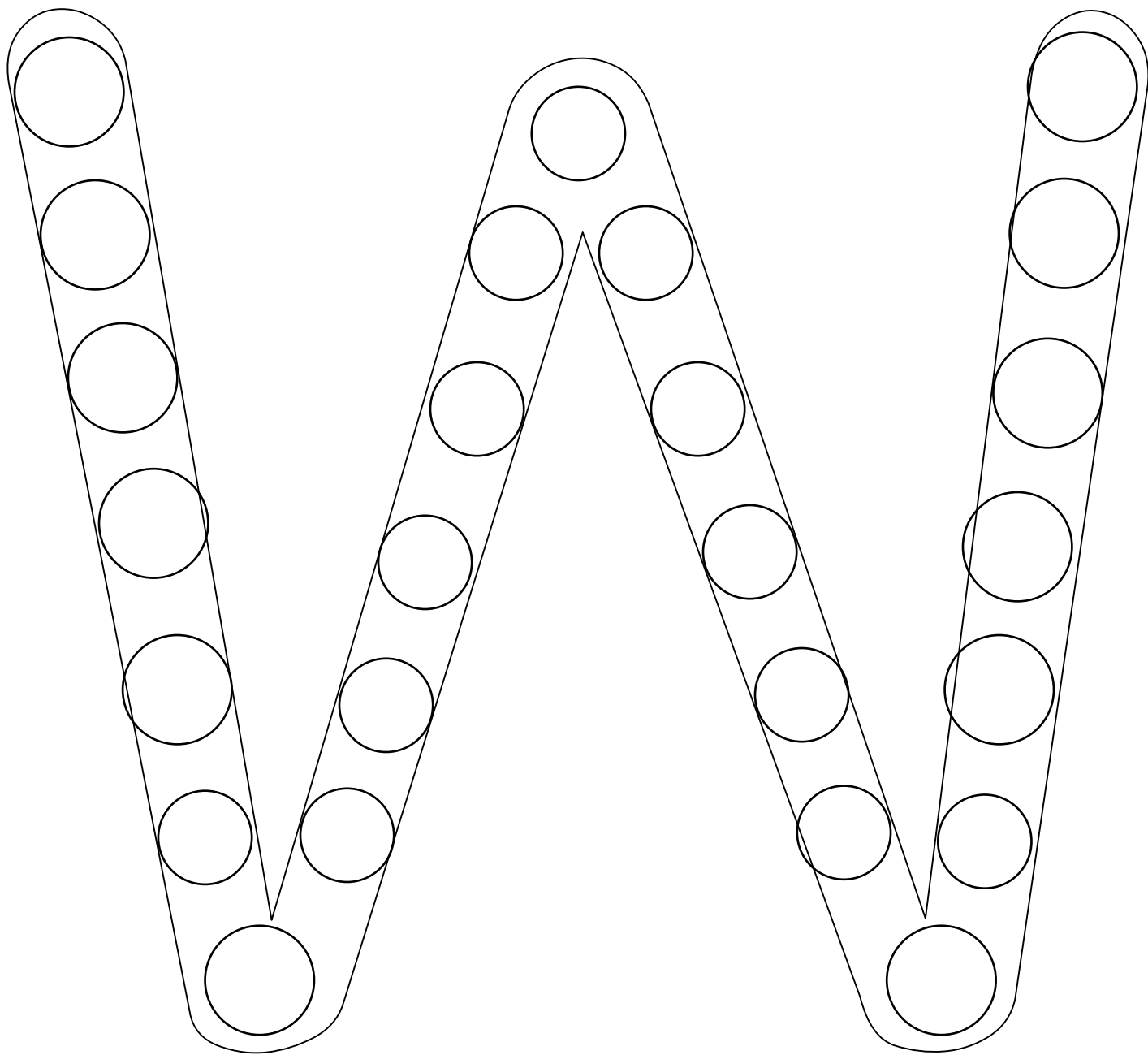


Option 2: Fill each circle with plastic counters, pennies or cereal



Option 3: Use finger paint to put a thumbprint in each circle

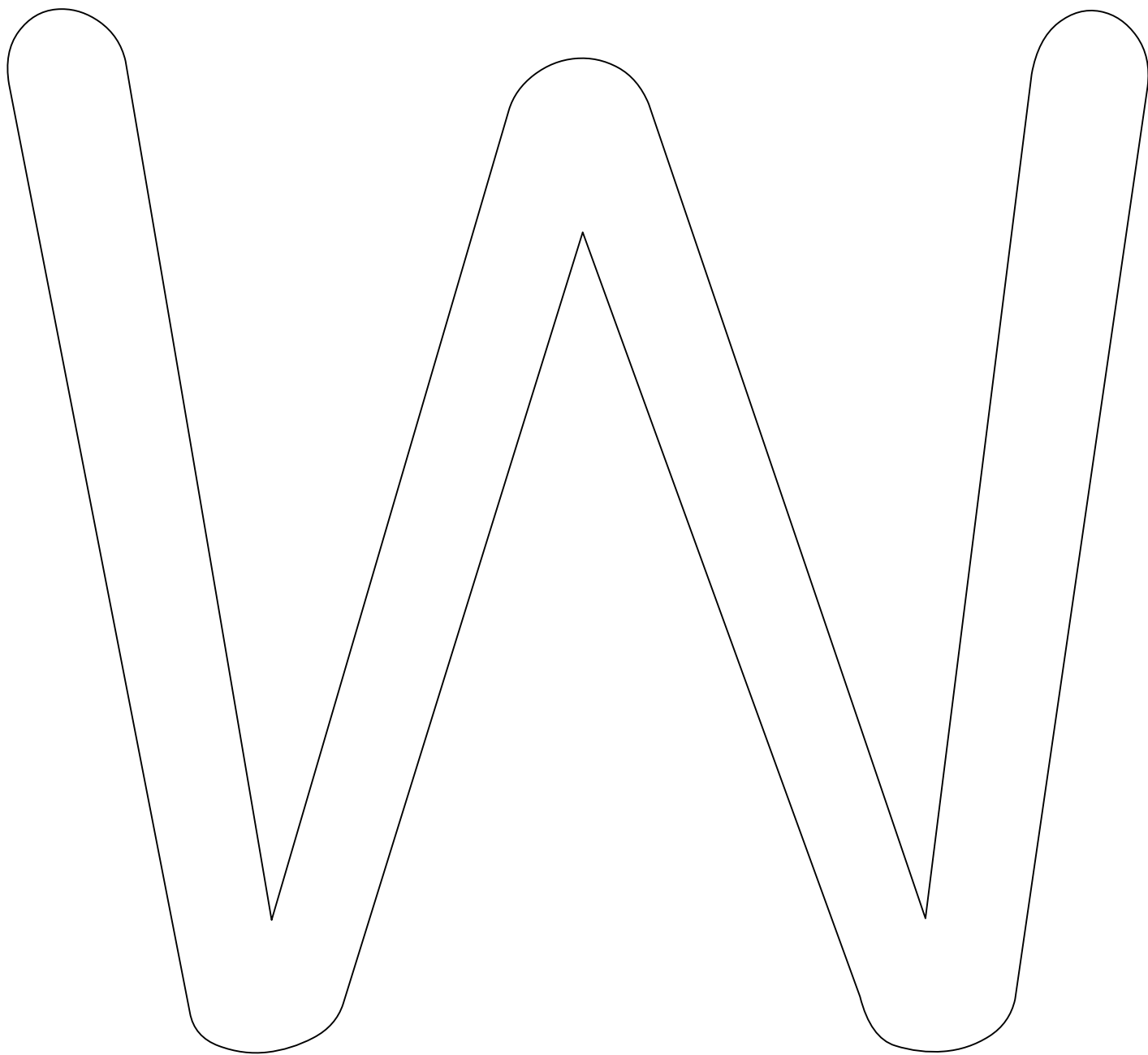

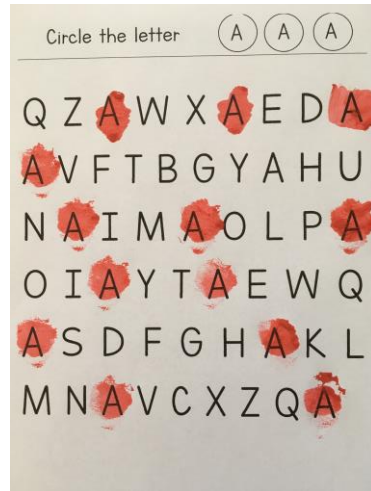

## Find the Letter

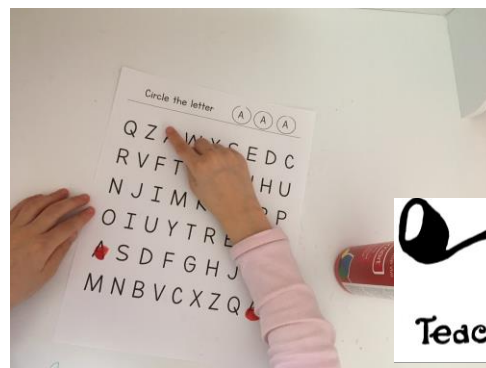
**Option 1: Use dot paint sticks or paint on a cotton ball to cover the letter**



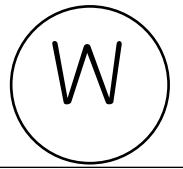
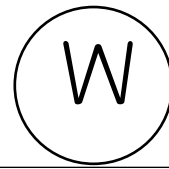
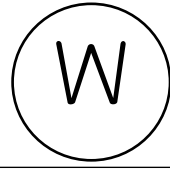
**Option 2: Cover the letter with plastic counters, pennies or cereal**

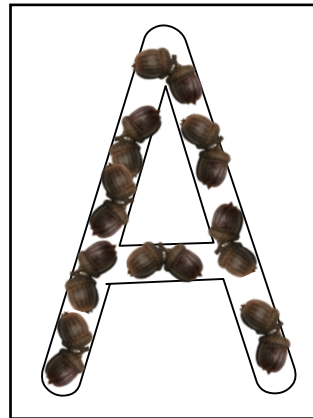
# Friday
