#### **Activities:**



Give each child a card with one way to say hello in another language (written phonetically). Tell them not to let any of the other children see their card. Ask the children to pretend that they are at the Tower of Babel and all of the sudden they start to speak another language. Have them form pairs by saying hello in the language of their card to everyone, until they meet the person with the same language.

Tower of Babel coin toss: Print the tower sheets onto yellow or tan paper. Laminate if desired. Tape together to create a Tower of Babel and have children try to toss a coin as close to the top as they can.

Teach children how to say hello in different languages: Hola, Ciao, Bonjour, Shalom, Aloha, Ni Hao.

Where is heaven? Do you think you could ever climb there by building a tower high enough? Why not? Ask children to name good works (helping others, giving to poor, etc.) and each draw a picture on an index card of a different one. Place each index card onto a step ladder. Can this ladder reach to heaven? No! Neither can doing good things get a person into heaven. God wants us to do good things because they are good, but He doesn't want us to think that being good will ever keep us from needing Him. Have children draw a picture of themselves serving God.
