

## Activities:



Have children take their shoes off and show them a jacket with empty pockets and several household items (keys, sunglasses, etc) They must walk from the door to the other side of the room, put on their shoes, put on the jacket, and fill the pockets with the items, then return to the door. Time each child to see who can do this the fastest. This is how the Israelites felt rushed when they were preparing to leave Egypt.

Let children make paper balls to throw at the teacher with the teacher holding up a shield. Count how many hits they made. Then, have them do it again without the shield. Count how many hits. God is like our shield. He protects us from things that are trying to harm us.

Show children a shallow bowl of water with pepper sprinkled in it. Invite them to quickly dip a finger in the middle.

Just like their fingers do nothing, Moses and the Israelites could do nothing to the Red Sea. Only the hand of God could move the water.

Cover your finger with dish soap and dip it in the water, causing all the pepper to move away.

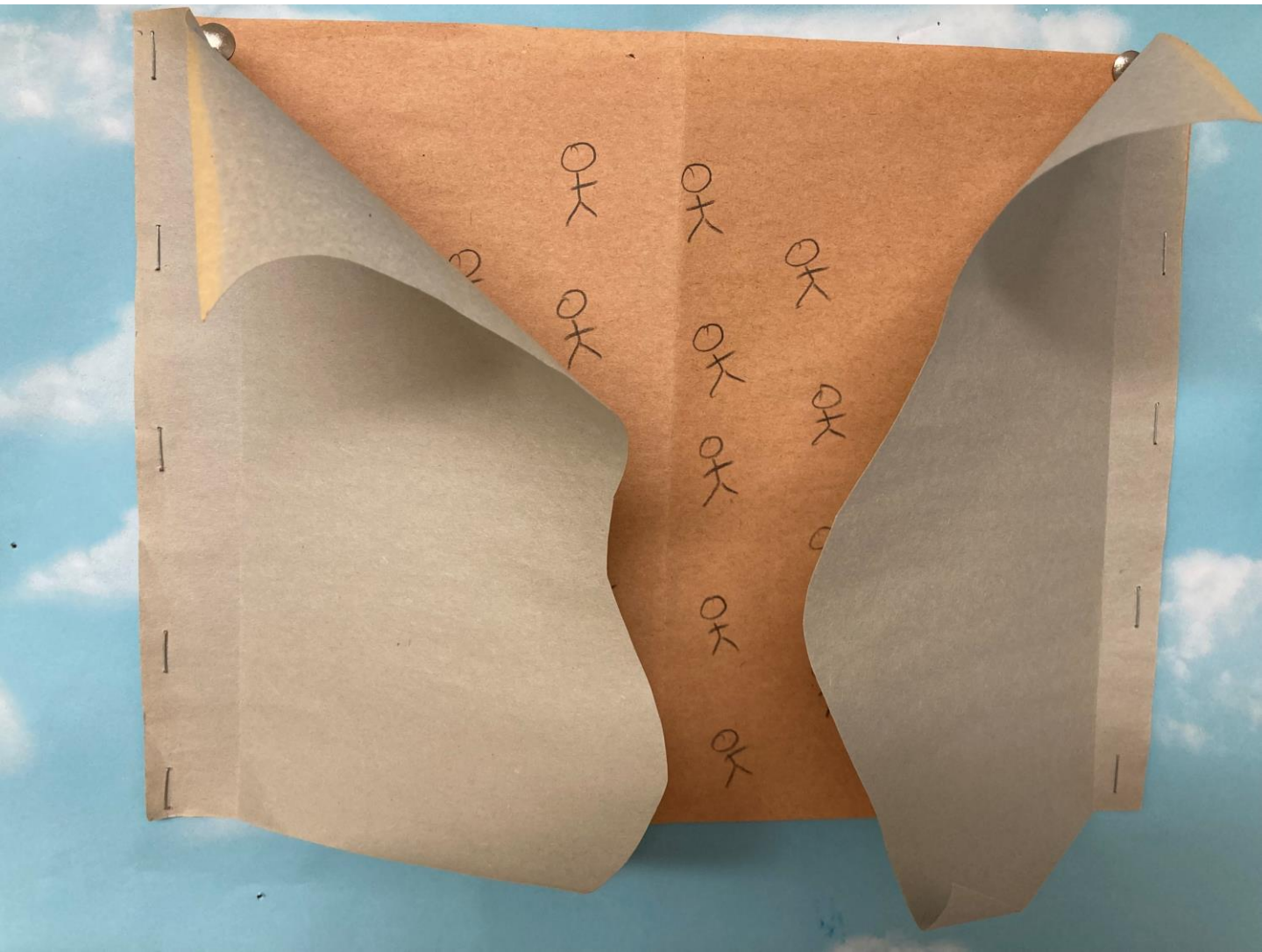
# Crossing the Red Sea

Encourage children to make a flat sheet of dough to represent the Red Sea. Have them split it in two and roll back each side. Give them toy people to march through it.

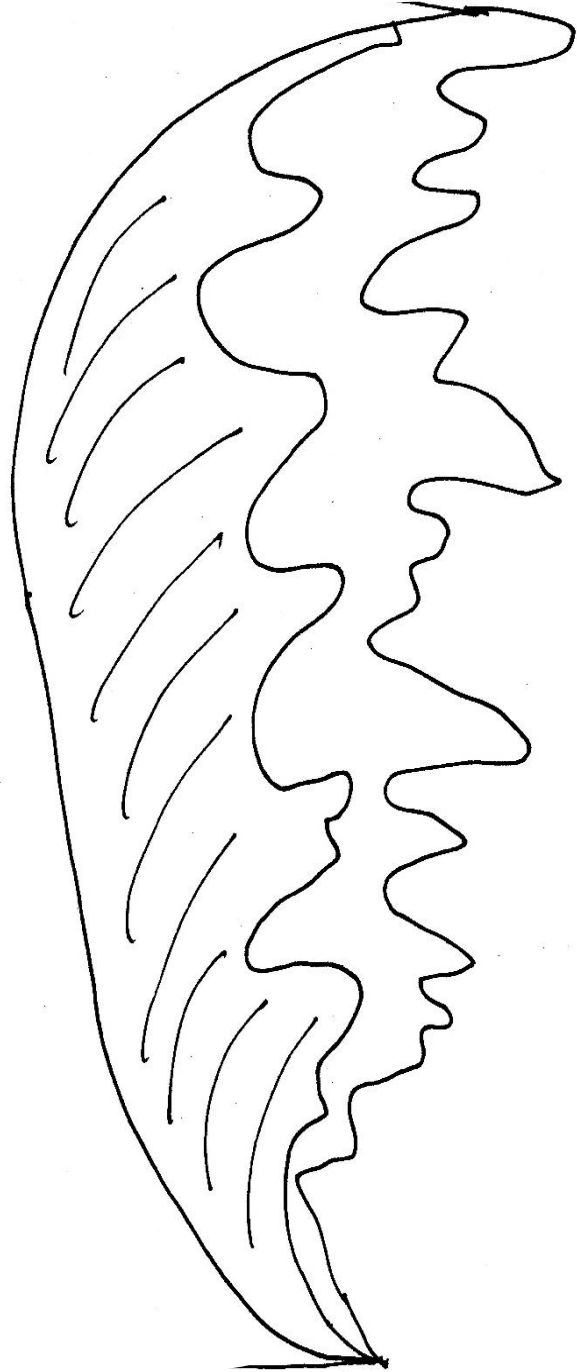
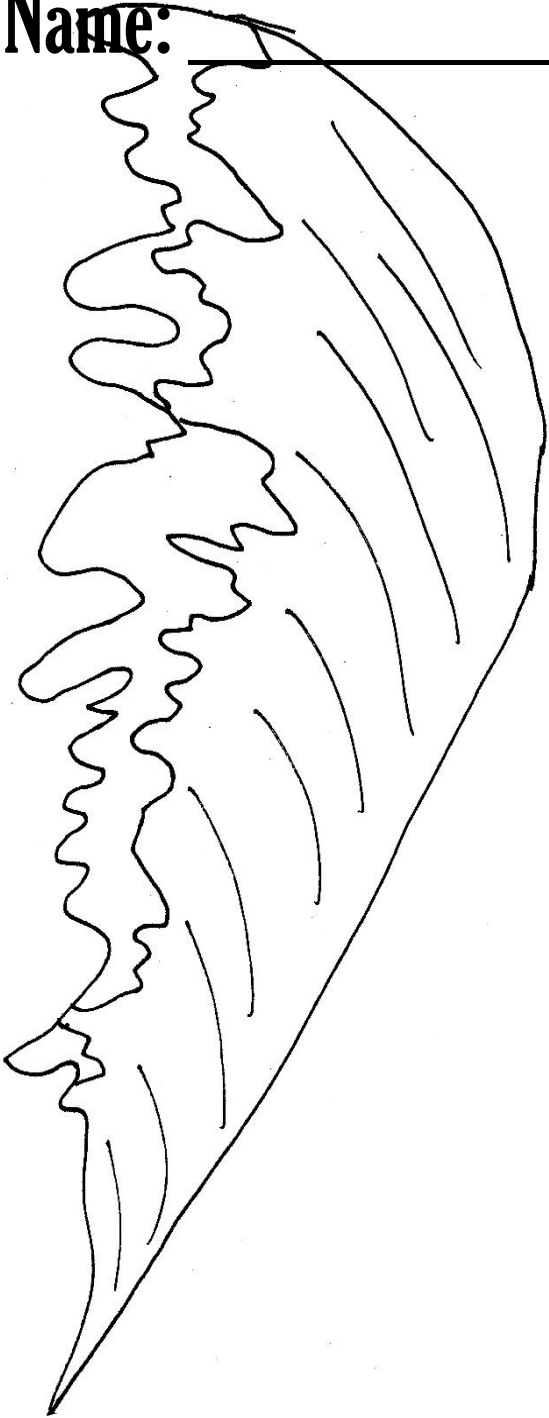
## Sensory Bag
