

Activities:



Play 20 questions with famous character or real people The Israelites might have felt like this before Jesus came. They had clues from Isaiah and other prophets, but they had to think hard.

Show children a small puzzle with half the pieces missing. Ask them to guess what the picture is. It is hard to figure it out with only half the pieces in place. Each time you add a piece, you have a better idea of what the whole picture shows.

Show children a piece of stained clothing (you can make a red stain with food dye). Have you ever had an injury and bled all over some nice white clothes? It is very difficult to get the red blood stains out of white clothes. Even bleach won't always work. God warns the Israelites to turn to Him for forgiveness. When they sin, it is like they are covered in blood. But God promises to clean off their sins.

Show children a large bowl of rice. Beforehand, place one bead in the rice for each child. Hand each child a glove and ask them to take turns trying to find something in the rice (don't tell them what they are looking for). Most won't find anything. Give the children another turn with the glove removed. Now, everyone should be able to find a bead. When people before Jesus read Isaiah's words, it was confusing. They weren't sure exactly what they were looking for. Now that we know Jesus has come and fulfilled so many prophecies, it is obvious.

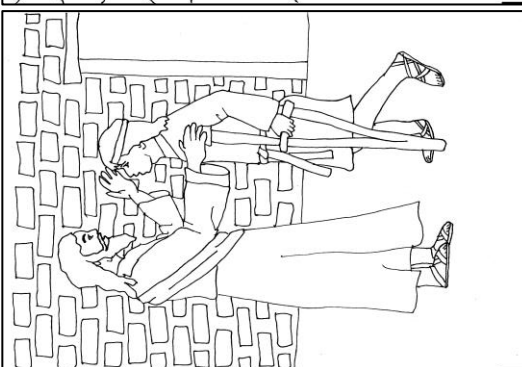
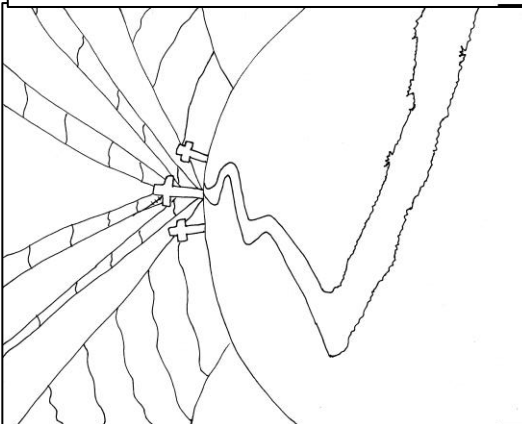
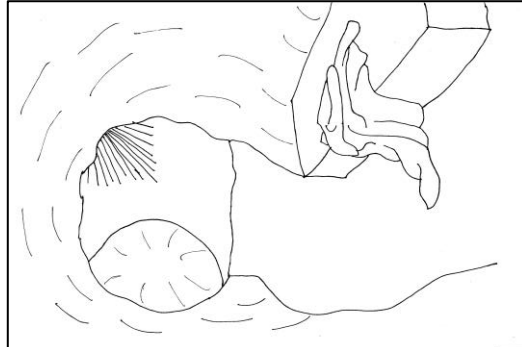

- ❖ Teacher helps roll up like scroll and ties with yarn

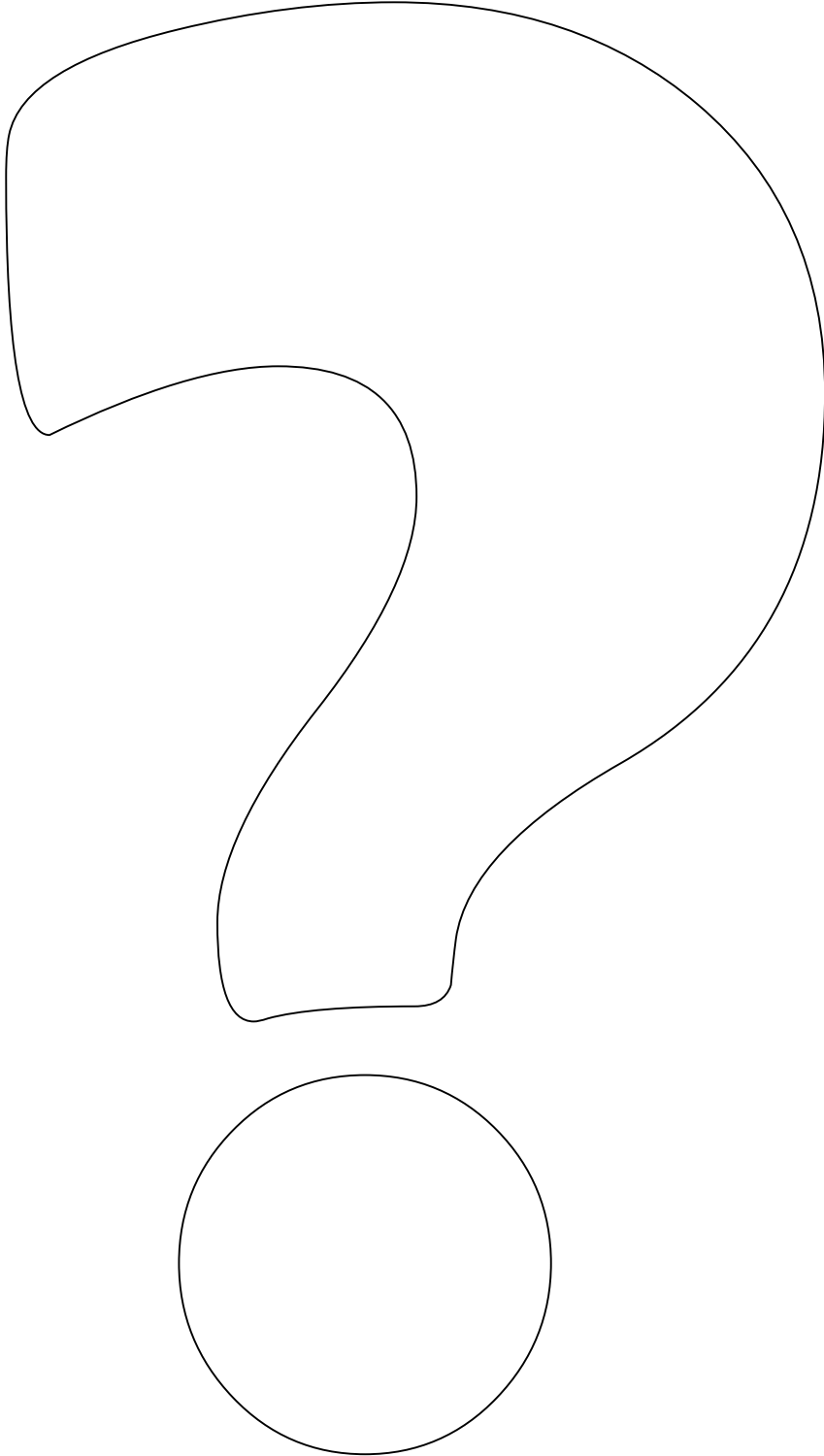
