Activities:



Show children a compass or GPS. Ask them to describe what it does. It guides us in the right direction. The Bible is like our compass, and the ten commandments are like a 'short versions' of God's Word.

Play a game of limbo and tell children whoever can make it under on all rounds will win a ticket to the best place ever! Lower it each time, until it is impossible for anyone to go under. No one wins the ticket. When the stick was up high, it was easy. But as it got lower, it was harder to make it. Eventually, it was impossible. Some of the commandments are easy to follow, others are harder. It is impossible for any of us to follow all the commandments all the time. We are not perfect. But Jesus is. He lived a perfect life and obeyed all these commandments every day He lived. He never sinned, ever. Think about getting into Heaven like getting under the limbo stick. You can only enter if you're perfect, which means none of us could enter. But Jesus offers for us to enter on His ticket. He is the only one who could win the limbo contest. We can only enter Heaven through Him, not on our own.




