Activities:



Split class in half and give small towels to each child. Put them opposite each other, about 6 feet, facing each other with a basket on one end. Have child at end farthest from basket take a small toy and bounce it off their towel onto the next child's towel. Have each child do this until the object is in the basket. If it drops, it has to start with the first child again.

Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego had to stick together and encourage each other during this time. When you are faced with temptation, having friends who want to obey God too can help you do the right thing.

Imagine having your name changed because you moved to a new country. Give children several 1" pieces of paper. Have them write each letter of their first and last (or first and middle) names on each paper. Tell them to rearrange them to create a new name for themselves.

Have children draw the head of the statue, then pass their paper to the child on their left. Add the torso to the paper they receive then pass it again. Continue until the statue has been drawn, each part by a different person. Explain that after the Babylonian Empire (gold head), came the Medo-Persian Empire (silver torso) which was less powerful. After that came the Greek Empire (brass), and then the Roman Empire (iron) which was later divided (iron & clay).



Ask children to share things they have dreamed about and mold them, or to mold themselves sleeping.


Game:
