Christmas Games

- Christmas Carol Charades: standard charades rules-one person gives clues by showing the number of words, which word is to be guessed, "sounds like," and acting out words. No speaking is allowed.
- * Reverse Charades: same as above, only the whole team acts out the scene for the guesser.
- Draw a Picture: one person draws the item shown, but cannot write any words or make any sounds.
- Sculpt with Clay: one person sculpts the image seen on the card. This one is preferable for younger players.

Print and cut out cards. Discard those that will not work for your group. Divide group into two or more teams.

Two Ways to Play:

- Play each set separately.
- Print each set on different colored paper. Shuffle the cards together, or keep in separate piles and contestants may choose which type of challenge they prefer.




