Activities:



In a large area play a game of red light/green light. Make the green lights very short and the red lights very long. Ask if children became frustrated over this. Is it frustrating to keep getting interrupted? The Israelites wanted to get something done, but others kept interrupting them. Ask children throughout the story to tell you if the Israelites are facing a red light or a green light.

The Israelites' hearts had fallen asleep. They had forgotten God's teaching and were ignoring their own sins. God used Ezra to wake them up and remember. Turn off the light and have children pretend to sleep. Tap one child on the shoulder to be "Ezra." When the lights come on, Ezra taps a child's shoulder and says, "Wake up and follow God!" Then both children do the same, until all children have woken up.

Show students a mirror. Ask them if what they see looks like them when they look into it. Then, show them their reflection with a spoon. Ask them if it still looks just like them. Explain that we are made in God's image, but because of sin in the world, the image we have of Him is twisted, like in the spoon.

Play a video clip of The Hebrew Slaves Chorus from Nabucco, by Giuseppe Verdi.






Craft

Modeling Dough:


Encourage children to make the temple and a heart. Talk about which one is more important.
