- > THE ARC REPRESENTS A NEW HORIZON.
- COLOR THE JUNETEENTH FLAG DARK BLUE ON THE TOP HALF, AND RED ON THE BOTTOM HALF. LEAVE THE 5-POINTED STAR AND THE OUTLINE OF THE 12-POINTED STAR WHITE.
