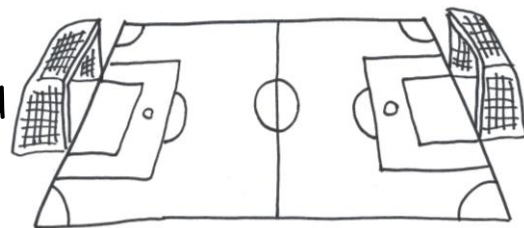
The Bank Got Robbed



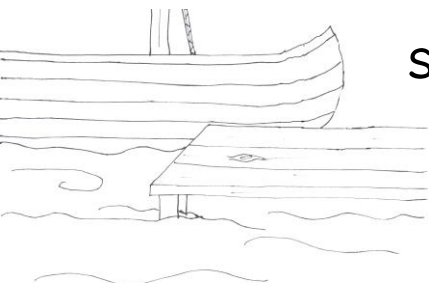
“Help! Help!” cried the man in the bank. “A thief stole the bag of coins and a piece of gold chain that belongs to my niece!”
