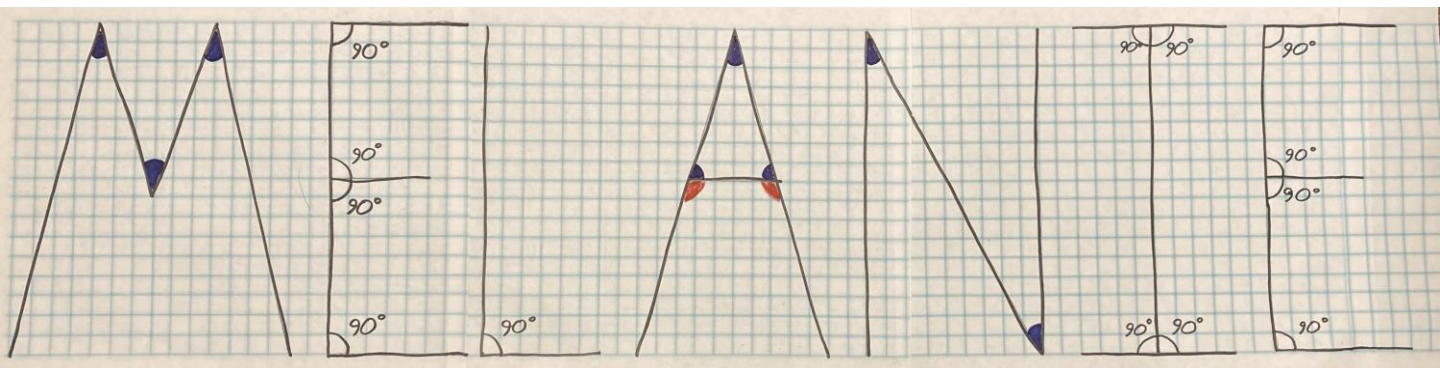


Use this fun project to evaluate students knowledge of measuring angles.
