For the student who is a true lover of nature and can always find interesting and unique uses for plants.




Clara Barton Award

For the student who is always looking for ways to help others, putting the needs of classmates ahead of your own.








For the student whose wit and humor light up our class, always sharing informative and thoughtful quips that make us think.
