

Build a Paper Chair

Divide students into groups of 4-6.

Materials:

- 10 pieces of copy paper
- Masking of Scotch tape
- A small stuffed animal

Give students a set amount of time (30 minutes is a good amount) to gather as a team and:

- Brainstorm how to make their chair
- Test their design
- Balance the stuffed animal

Allow about another 15 minutes at the end for each group to present their findings to the class.
