Type out your spelling words on a computer, or even an old keyboard.



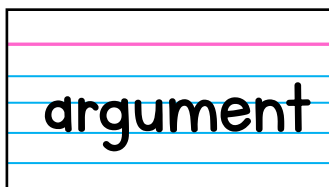
## Bubble Words

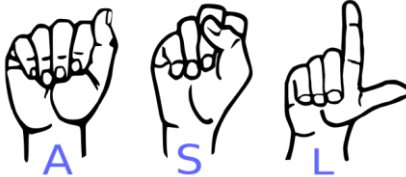

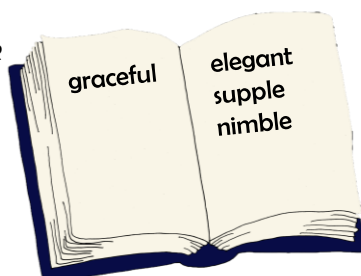
