Animal, Vegetable or Mineral

Also known as 20 questions, the above name is the first question to ask (narrowing the thing to guess down to a person/animal, plant, or non-organic item). You can limit the guesses to 20, or let it be unlimited.

I Spy: Speed Round

Since items are constantly moving, there has to be a limit of seconds for I Spy in the car. Also, instead of just naming colors, you can choose hints like, "something that starts with an A," "something flat," or, "something that makes deliveries."

G-H-O-S-T

Name a word that has at least 5 letters. If the word is "banana," the first person says B, the second person says A, the third person says N, and so on. Whoever finishes the word earns the letter G. When someone gets all the letters in GHOST, the game ends. (Up to you if earning GHOST means winning or losing.)

Train of Thought

First person says literally anything, ie; koala bears. Second person says, "Koala bears make me think of ____." The next person says, "____ makes me think of ____." Continue as long as everyone is having fun. See if you can circle back to the original item.



The ABC Game

For this game, name different items in alphabetical order by category. There are two ways to play:

- 1) The first person names an item in the category that starts with an A, the second person names an item in the category that starts with a B, and so on.
- 2) Everyone calls out items in the category that start with A (or takes turns). When no one can think of any more items, everyone moves onto the letter B, and so on.
