Intro:	<p>What is the umpire's job in a baseball game? How many strikes does a player get before they're out? Does God stop loving us if we strike out and make mistakes in life? No! But does that mean he'll let us get away with doing the same bad thing over and over again? Today we'll talk about a time when God gave His people many chances, but they kept disobeying until they were out.</p>

Volunteers:	2 spies wearing "disguises" and carrying top secret folder, batter
teacher pretends to throw ball, calls out strikes; batter swings each time teacher says "complained"	God wanted to bring the Israelites to the Promised Land. But the problem was they didn't believe He was really going to take care of them. They complained when He wanted to rescue them from Egypt. Strike 1! They complained when they got to the Red Sea. Strike 2! They complained when the water was bitter. Strike 3! They complained when they didn't have food. Strike 4! They complained when they didn't have water. Strike 5! They complained when Moses went up the mountain to get the Ten Commandments. Strike 6!
spies put on sunglasses and walk behind room divider or curtain	The Israelites had finally come to the end of their journey. Before going to their new home, they wanted to see what it was like. They chose one person from each of the twelve tribes to go on a secret mission to spy out the land.
spies carry stick with balloons	They went to the land and saw the towns and the people. They brought back huge bunches of grapes to show the Israelites how good the food was.

everyone fold arms and shake heads	The Israelites complained that God didn't love them. They didn't believe He would protect them. They wanted to choose a new leader and turn around.
"You're out!"	God told the Israelites they had used up all their chances. Now He wouldn't let them move to the Promised Land.
baby doll	But God would only punish the adults who disobeyed. When their children grew up, He would still let them move there, because they were not the ones who disobeyed Him. God is always fair.
faithfulness fruit	There will always be things in life that are scary. But we can trust God to watch over us. If God tells us to do something, we can have faith that He will help us to do it. If you want proof that God is powerful, just look in your Bible!

Play "I Spy"


