Isobars



Isobars are lines of air pressure. Draw isobars on the map to create your own air pressure map. Isobar lines may never cross or touch. Air pressure numbers are usually between 950 and 1050 millibars.

After your teacher has checked them, cover your lines with glue and add string. Attach a small piece of paper to the string with a hole punch labeling the isobar.
