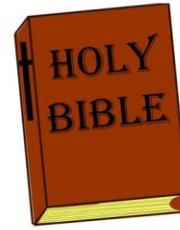

## Checklist

Topic:	Gabriel's Announcements
Intro:	Show sealed envelopes to students (if possible, write their names on the cards first). Ask if students like getting something in the mail. What is a fun thing to get in the mail (a gift, a card, etc). Who brings the mail? (the postal worker) This person is a messenger. Did they write the letter or buy the gift? (no) Imagine getting a letter in the mail that told you your future. Would you be surprised?
The Trinity	Review the meaning of the Trinity: 1 God, 3 Parts (Persons). We do not worship three separate gods. Jesus is God the Son.
measuring tape and globe in hallway	In a large area, have two children, wearing "Creation" and "End Times" signs, stretch out a measuring tape all the way. Place the globe in the middle. Have another child, wearing "Jesus" sign, walk around them in a circle.
Time	Jesus existed since forever in Heaven with God the Father and God the Holy Spirit. He has no beginning and no end, but at one point, He entered earth's timeline. The Israelites had been waiting for the coming of the Messiah for a very long time. They knew God had promised a rescuer, but they did not know when He would come.

	Finally, the time had come for the Messiah to arrive. God sent a special messenger ahead. Who were God's messengers in the Bible? (angels) Angels are like God's mailmen. They go wherever God sends them and deliver His messages. They do not say anything except what God wants them to.

<p>Note to Teacher:</p>	<p>*If children ask for a meaning of the word virgin, a working definition can be "a single girl who cannot have a baby yet." (Thus, why it was an extra special miracle...other women in the Bible had had babies after they no longer could, but this was the only time a girl had a baby <i>before</i> she could)</p>
	<p>Imagine being Mary. How would you react to an angel suddenly appearing before you? How did she react to being told God was with her? (she was confused) What did the angel reassure her? (Don't be afraid, God is pleased with you)</p>

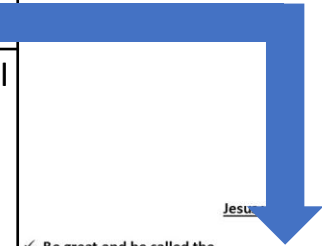

	What incredible things did Gabriel promise about Jesus? (He would be king, He would rule forever, His kingdom would never end)

	God's message to Mary was that she would have a son who would be king. Mary and Joseph may have been descendants of King David, but they were poor, simple people, who did not live at all like royalty. Why did Mary not understand how she could have a son? (she expected to get married before having a baby) Gabriel explained that this would be a miracle and gave an example of another miracle that had just happened in her family.
	How did Mary react to all of this? (she said she's the Lord's servant) What does this attitude say about her? Mary probably had plans for what she thought her life would be like. God was blessing her, but it also meant her life would become difficult. Did Mary think about how this would affect her life? (no) How did she respond? (Let it happen as God said)

Have each child say their first, middle and last name. Ask how they got their names (after a grandparent, a place, a character in a book). Why are names important?

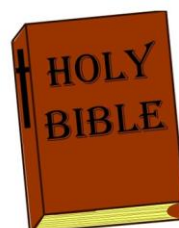
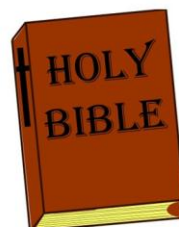

But God had a different plan. Bethlehem was the hometown of King David. God wanted to make sure people understood that Jesus was special. What are some of the ways He made it obvious? (having Jesus born in Bethlehem, the descendant of King David, making His birth a miracle, having another miracle birth in the same family around the same time, etc.)

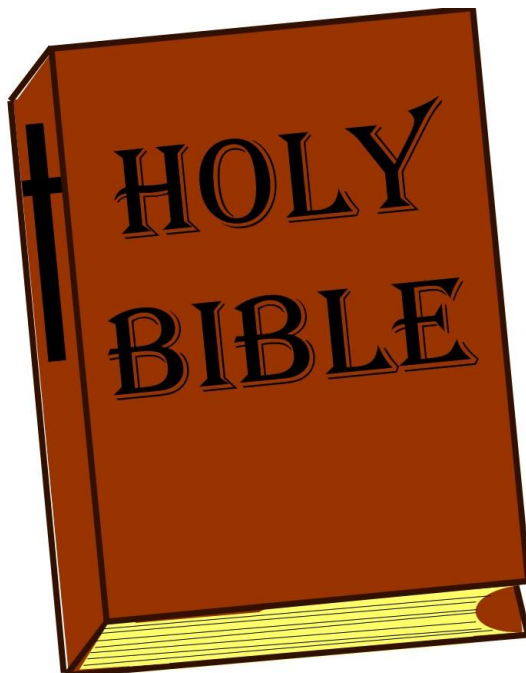
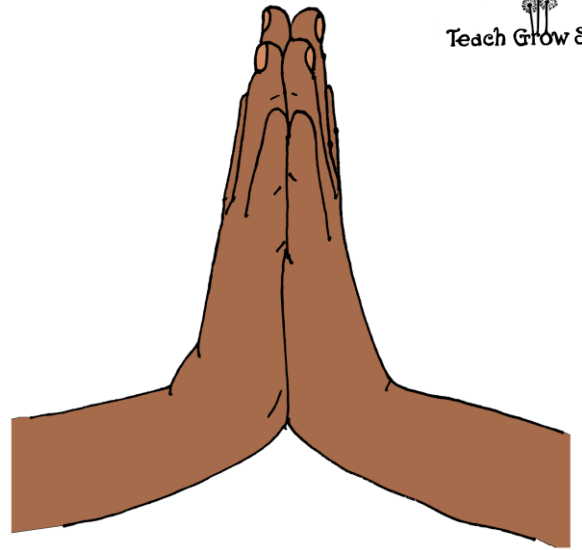
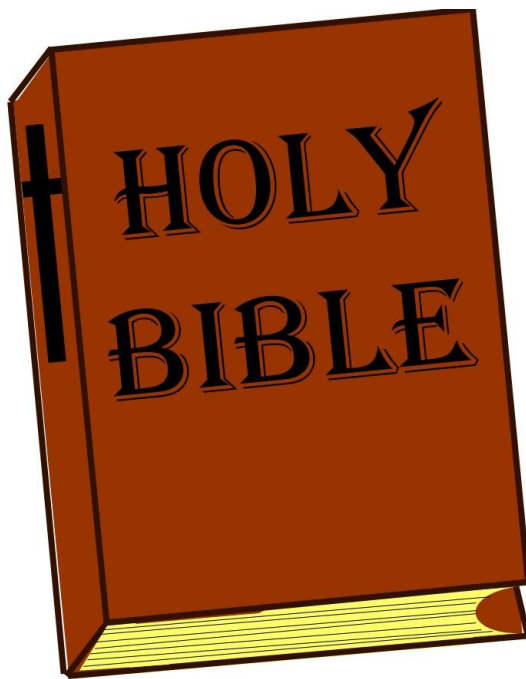
