Story:	Hannah
Focus:	We can share our true feelings when we talk to God in prayer.
Object:	x-ray
Intro:	Have you ever had to go to the doctor to get an x-ray? Why does the doctor need to do this? They can't always tell if we have something wrong just by looking at us. Our inside looks very different from our outside. Do you know who else can see inside us? (God) Not only can God see inside our bodies, He can see inside our hearts, too. He doesn't need an x-ray to know what we're thinking, or how we're feeling. He knows us inside out.
Volunteers:	Hannah, Eli, Samuel
Props:	2 (or 3) baby dolls
Hannah prays, leader holds baby doll in air over her head	Hannah loved God very much. She prayed to Him a lot. Hannah really wanted a baby. She prayed to God for many years to give her a baby. But she still didn't have one.
Hannah cries	When Hannah saw other moms with lots of kids, it made her sad that she didn't have any.
Hannah walks around in circle	Every year, Hannah and her husband went to the tabernacle to worship God. They had to travel a long way.
Hannah prays	Hannah went in to pray for a baby. She promised God to dedicate the baby to Him. She was so sad, she swayed back and forth while her lips moved.
Eli folds arms and shakes head	The priest, Eli, thought this was very weird. He thought she was just goofing off and told her not to behave that way in God's house.
	But Hannah wasn't goofing off. She was telling God just how she felt.


