Each following player names the previously named items before adding an item of their own.



Example:



Player 1: I'm going out in the snow and I'm bringing my boots.




Player 2: I'm going out in the snow and I'm bringing my boots and gloves.



Player 3: I'm going out in the snow and I'm bringing my boots, gloves, and hat.

Each person names an item to bring to a Valentines party.


Each following player names the previously named items before adding an item of their own.

Player 3: I'm going to a Valentines party and I'm bringing heart cookies, chocolate kisses, and stickers.

Sit in a circle.


Each person names something green. Each following player names the previously named items before adding an item of their own.

Example:

Player 1: I see green wherever I go. I see clover.

Player 2: I see green wherever I go. I see clover and trees.

Player 3: I see green wherever I go. I see clover, trees, and ivy.



Easter Egg Hunt Memory Game

Play this fun game to help children practice their memory skills.

Sit in a circle.

Each person names they might get in their Easter basket.

Each following player names the previously named items before adding an item of their own.

Example:

Player 1: On Easter morning I found a chocolate bunny in my basket.

Player 2: On Easter morning I found a chocolate bunny and candy eggs in my basket.

Player 3: On Easter morning I found a chocolate bunny, candy eggs, and marshmallows in my basket.

Each person names they might see on a walk in the springtime.


Each following player names the previously named items before adding an item of their own.

Each person names they might need to bring to the beach.


Each following player names the previously named items before adding an item of their own.

Each person names they might on a farm.


Each following player names the previously named items before adding an item of their own.

Each person names they might need on the first day of school.


Each following player names the previously named items before adding an item of their own.

Each person names things they like to do in autumn.


Each following player names the previously named items before adding an item of their own.

Each person names what they will bring to Thanksgiving dinner.


Each following player names the previously named items before adding an item of their own.

Each person names what they will do at Christmas time.


Each following player names the previously named items before adding an item of their own.

Each person names what they will bring to school in their backpack.


Each following player names the previously named items before adding an item of their own.
