

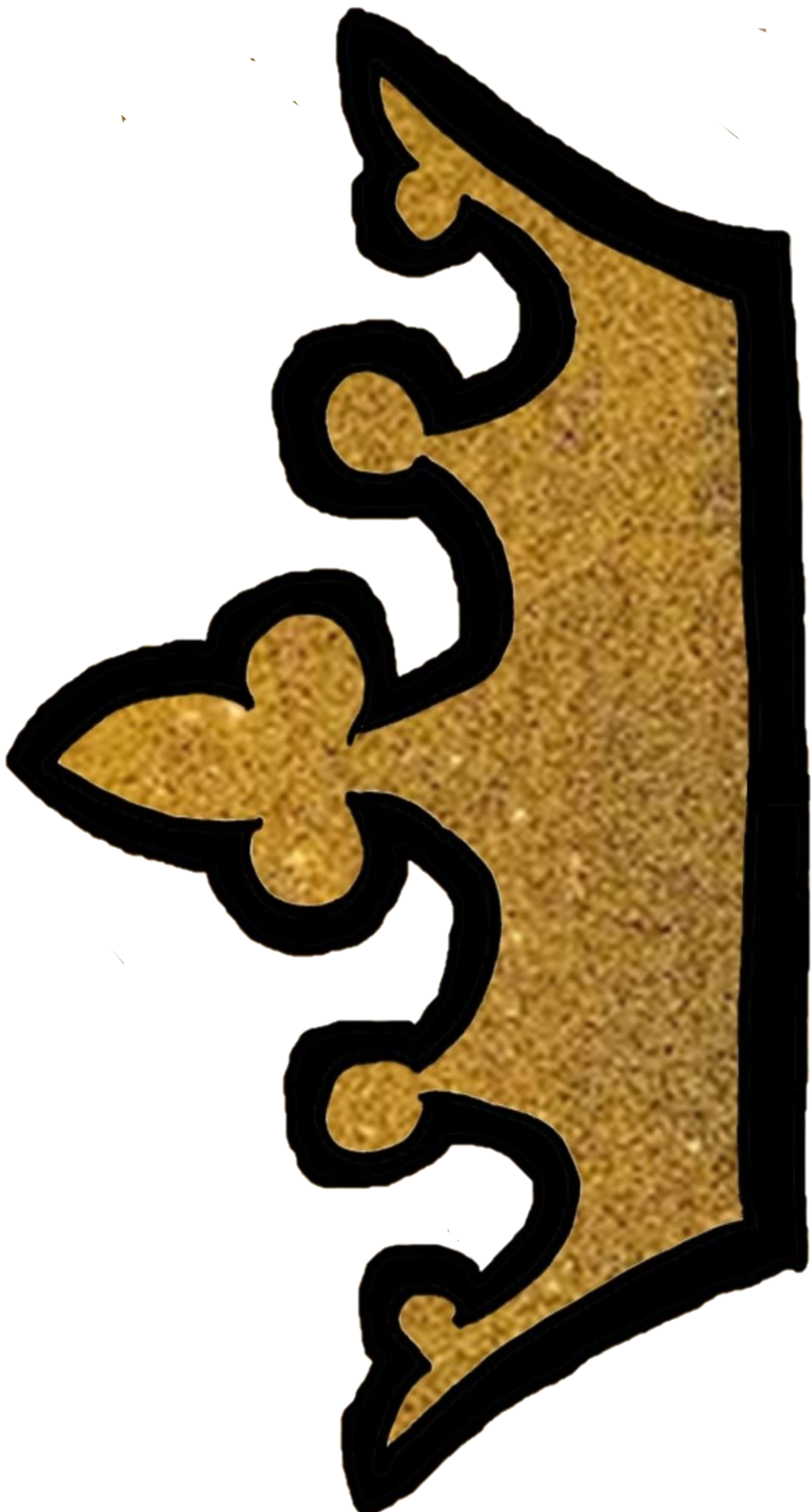

| Skit (All Ages) | |
| Setup: | Furniture on side with brown or gray cloth draped over it as cave, nice chair as throne |
| Volunteers: | David, Saul wearing crown and robe with matching belt taped to bottom |
| | King Saul and David were playing a game of chase. But it wasn't a very fun game. King Saul wasn't playing nicely. |
| David in cave | First David hid in caves and and Saul looked for him. |
| David plays toy harp | David sang lots of songs to God during this time. He knew that God was watching over him. |
| David leaves cave, Saul enters | David went to the other side of the desert. Saul looked for him in a cave and rested for a bit. |
| David takes matching belt | David snuck in and took part of Saul's robe. He was so quiet that Saul never even noticed. |
| David waves cloth | David called out to Saul and held up the piece of his robe. He told him he could have gotten him right there. But he didn't. He wanted to play by the rules God had given them. |
| Saul kneels | David asked Saul why he wasn't playing fairly. Saul apologized and went back home. |

Game:

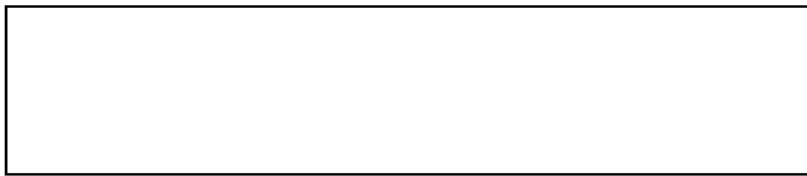
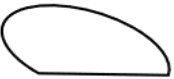
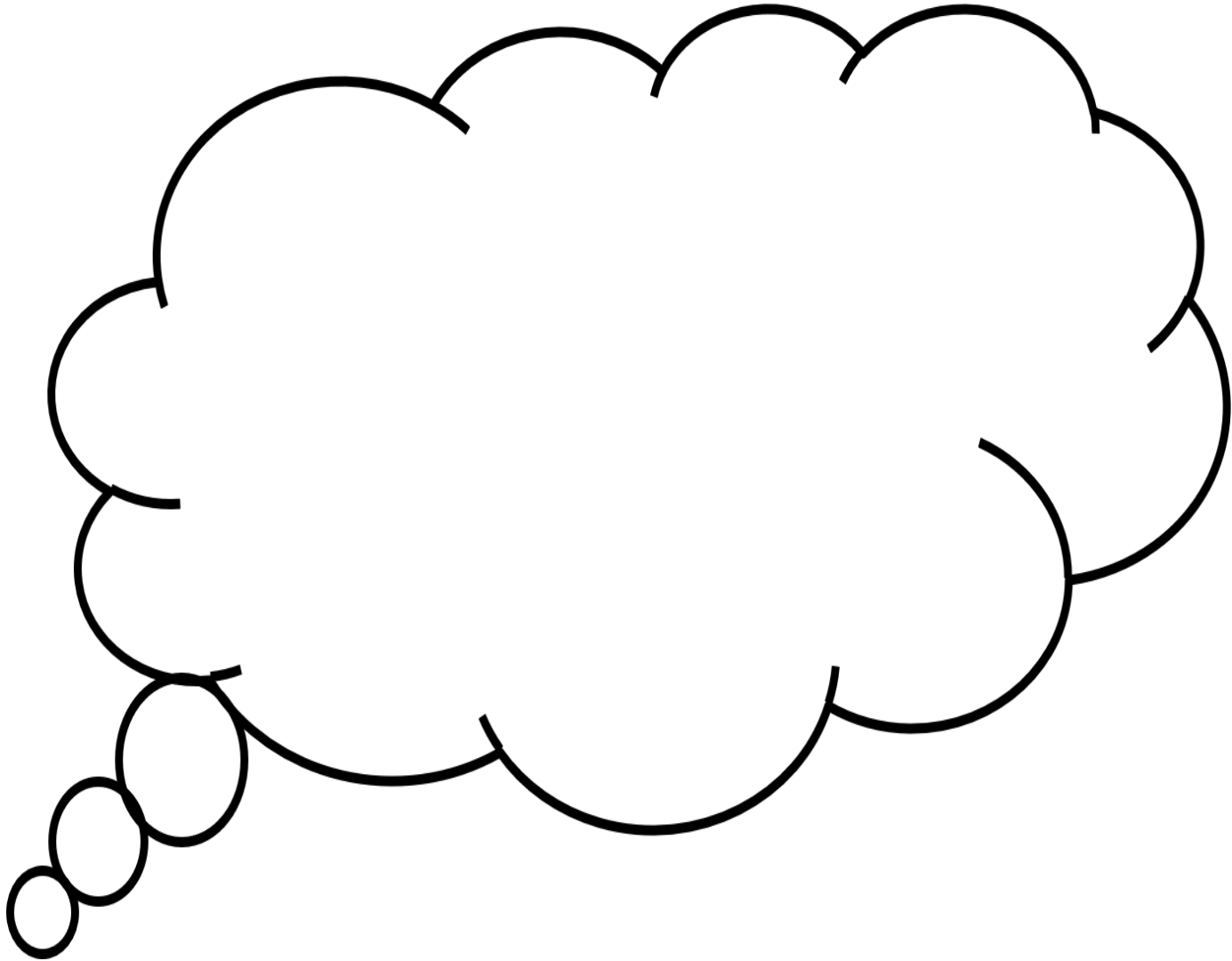
